

Mississippi Reapportionment Quick Facts

2000 Total State Pop: 2,844,666
2009 Estimated State Pop: 2,951,996
Percent change: +3.77%
Numeric Change: +107,330

HOUSE

Mississippi has 122 House seats. 39 are "Majority-Minority".

Using 2009 estimate, the ideal population size of a Miss. House District = 24,197

In 2000, the ideal House size was = 23,317

Change per House District 2000-2009(est) = +880

SENATE

Mississippi has 52 Senate seats. 12 are "Majority-Minority".

Using 2009 estimate, the ideal population size of a Miss. Senate District is = 56,769

In 2000, the ideal Senate size was = 54,705

Change per Senate District 2000-2009(est) = +2064

US CONGRESSIONAL DISTRICTS

Mississippi has 4 Congressional seats. 1 is "Majority-Minority".

Using 2009 estimate, the ideal population size of a Miss. Cong. District is = 737,999

In 2000, the ideal Congressional size was = 711,165

Change per Congressional District 2000-2009(est) = +26,834
